


IMPORTANT

The Cargo Case must be properly installed and securely attached to your vehicle. Failure to properly secure the mounts and cases to your vehicle could result in serious injury or even death.


Be sure to check the hardware after 10-20 miles after installation and after every trip off road to be sure it's still secured.


CARGO CASE INSTALLATION





Parallel with the crossbar.

Back side down (drag force).




Parallel with the vehicle's body.


For optimal accessibility, we recommend mounting the Cargo Case at the edge of the vehicle's roof, parallel to it's body.

HARDWARE PREPARATION

1 INSTALL BOTTOM RAIL




Insert x4 M8 bolts into the groove of the bottom side.






Adjust x2 M8 bolts on the 2 sides of the cross bar as the picture shows.






Attach Mounting Plate to M8 Bolts. Utilize the narrowest hole spacing allowed by your crossbar.



Tighten M8 Nuts until the mounting plate bends 5°-15°. Marking the bolt position as shown in the picture will help for future reattachment and to monitor the hardware.




Note: Hand tools are recommended to prevent nut and bolt from seizing.







- 2.1 Insert x6 M6 T-Nuts into the groove where you want to install the Molle Panel.
- 2.2 Insert x6 bolts and x6 washers as the picture shows, then tighten it.
- 2.3 You can customize the positioning of the Molle Panel, and subsequently secure it by tightening the T-Nuts.

3 INSTALL ITX LID ORGANIZER






The organizer can be attached to the velcro system on the lid.




M8 Bolt Water Drain System: To clean the Cargo Case, simply fill it with water and then open the bolt to drain.



Insert x4 T-Nuts, x4 M8 bolts and x4 washers into the groove where you want to install the Hard Binder then tighten it.

INSTALL ITX TIE DOWN STRAP



Wrap the strap securely around the item you want to secure. Ensure it's wrapped tightly and evenly.

CARGO CASE CARE AND SAFETY

CARGO CASE CARE:

- When not in use, store your aluminum Cargo Case in a cool, dry place out of direct sunlight.
- You can clean your aluminum cargo case with a mild soap and water. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the aluminum.



SAFETY:

- Always ensure that the latches and clasps are securely fastened before transporting or storing the case.
- Check hardware after 10-20 miles of initial driving and after every trip offroad to ensure every connection is secured.
- Gas struts are NOT to be used as handles. Doing so may cause gas struts to bend or gas leaking. Breaks of this kind are user error, not covered by our warranty policy.
- Keep gas struts rod away from dust as dust and rust may cause gas leakage.
- Before each camping season, or after prolonged use, be sure to check all the screws underneath the cargo case along the frame. Screws might be loosen over time due to vibration and gravity. Screws should be snug; but not overtightened. If you have any concerns please contact customer service at Intrepid Camp Gear.
